Organized meeting with ECVET experts and experts that are helping the industries with validation. The experts are in contact with more than 20 different industries


Existing tools and templates were compared during the meeting between the experts

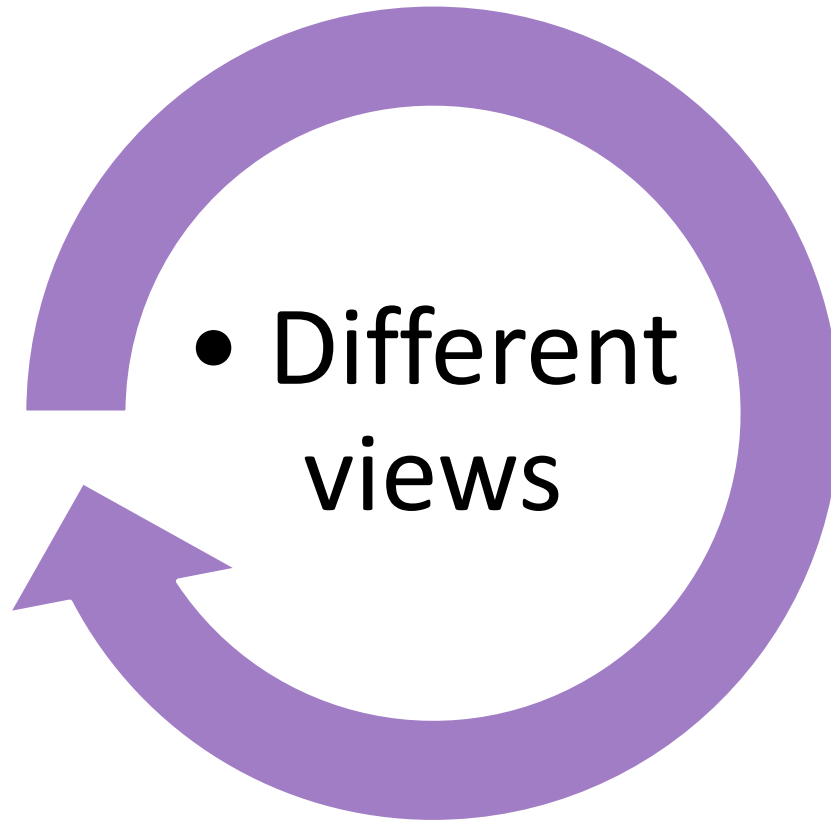
