

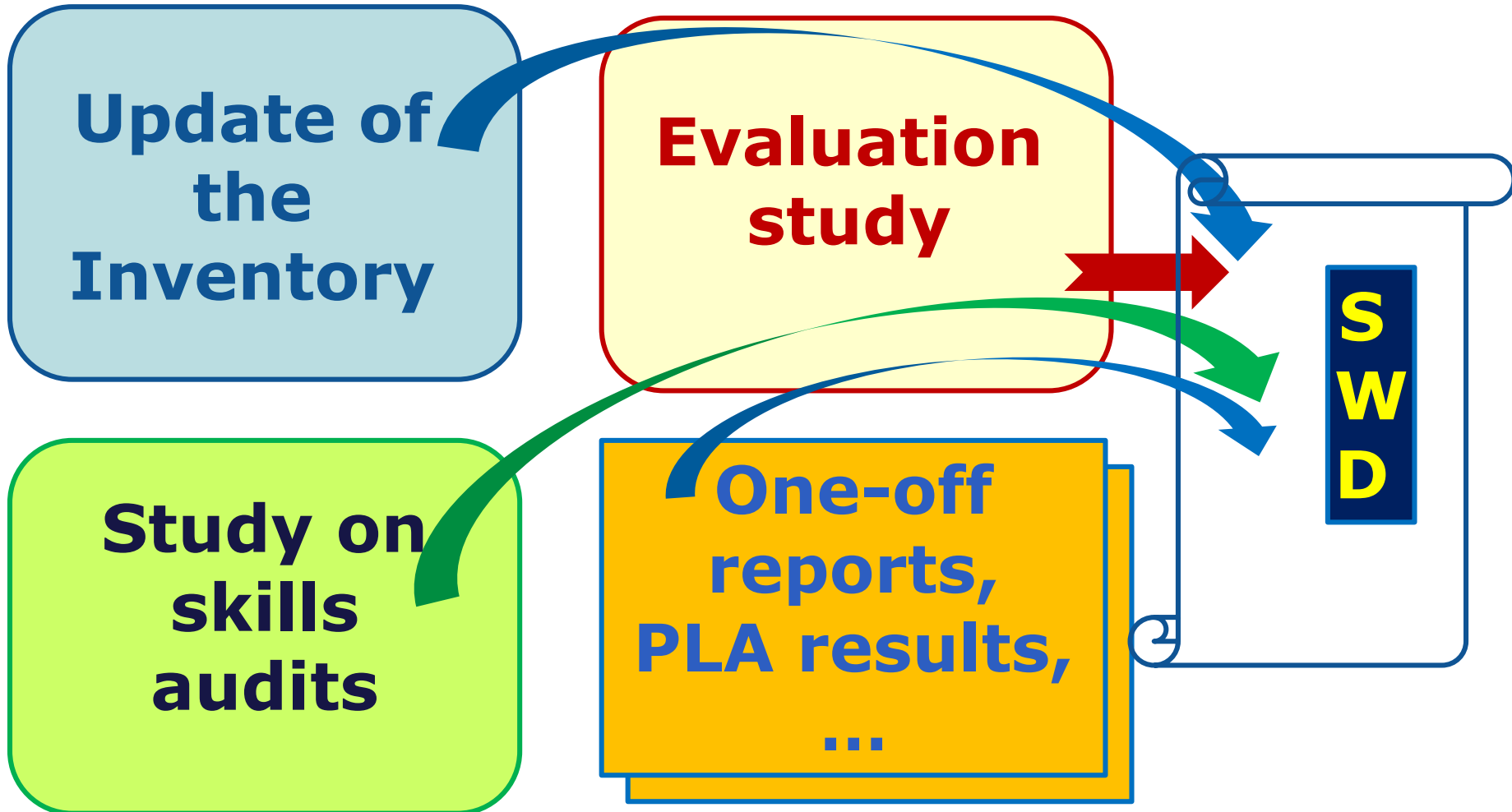

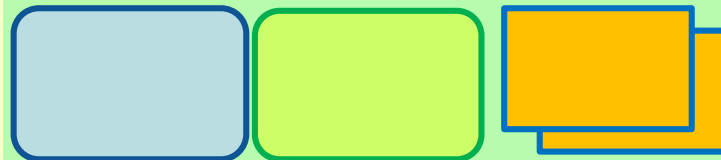

Evaluation study

- **Started in April 2019, final report envisaged for mid-February 2020**

- **Desk research**

- **Field work – 60 interviews (32)**

Two expert meetings

13 and 14 November 2019 – Brussels

Role of employers and labour market actors

Link to NQFs and learning outcomes

**Published 7 August 2019,
open until 13 November 2019**

- Information on respondent**
- Three questions to all respondents**

**Ten questions to
validation
specialists**

**Six questions to
beneficiaries of
validation**

- 193 respondents**
- 40 beneficiaries (including 'specialists')**

Interim findings

- **All countries provide some validation opportunities**
- **12 countries report increased use of validation**
- **In 20 countries validation leads to qualifications or formal credit**
- **In 18 countries validation includes all four stages, until certification**
- **Most countries have strong links between validation and NQFs**
- **In 23 countries, same qualification standards**

Coherence

- **About half countries report that the Recommendation is mostly consistent with national validation policy and measures**

Added value

- **Volume effect:
The Recommendation helped establish or raise the profile of validation frameworks**
- **It had direct impact on validation policies in 12 countries**
